Keynote Presentation

Suicidality & Self Injury in the School Age Population

Joshua Stein, MD - PrairieCare

This session will focus on the assessment, prediction and evaluation of suicidal thoughts and self-injury in the school age population. Common clinical language will be defined, and we will walk through the evaluation of risk factors as well as medicating supports. This session will be presented from a clinical perspective with the primary goal of educating participants and increasing their effectiveness in keeping students safe. Non-suicidal self-injury will also be reviewed with common cues and chronologic patterns over time. Finally, the spectrum of services available in the Twin Cities will be reviewed for the at-risk student.

Means Restriction Education

Kara Bennett, Coordinator of Suicide Prevention Programs - NAMI

Learn how to educate families on the importance of restricting access to lethal means when a family member is at risk of suicide. This workshop includes how to develop safe options for gun removal and storage and how to secure medications. This workshop is evidence-based practice, designed for crisis responders, medical and mental health professionals.

MSSWA has created a training on suicide awareness and prevention aimed to educate school social workers on evidence-informed suicide prevention practices and to empower school social workers with the necessary knowledge and tools to train others on suicide awareness and prevention. Participants will understand evidence-informed practices for suicide prevention in the school setting and will be equipped with the knowledge, skills and content needed to provide the MSSWA Suicide Awareness & Prevention training to teachers and other staff in need of suicide prevention professional development for teacher licensure in Minnesota. The interactive session will allow time to reflect and create an action plan on how this training content could be best utilized by you and your district.
